A two-page evidence pack the plant attaches. You file it.

The problem you already see

Carrier asks: is office IT separated from the machines that make the product? Who can remote into the line? Does that session expire? The plant says yes. They have no file. Submission comes back insufficient evidence. Renewal sits.

What we hand you

A two-page Insurance Evidence Pack. Score on the boundary. The actual firewall crossings. Named remote users. A 90-day list with owners and dates. The plant signs that the files they gave were accurate — not that they are unhackable.

What the plant must send

1. Firewall rule export — any brand, even a PDF or screenshot
2. List of who can remote into plant systems — VPN, TeamViewer, OEM
3. Latest asset spreadsheet
4. Four short talks: plant manager, IT, maintenance, one operator

About one hour of their time, total. We do not plug into the line.

What we will not do

No scan. No sensors. No cheap-premium promise. No taking over their IT. If the pack is red, page two is the homework. When they close it, we reprint for \$2,500.

Price and your cut

First plant \$9,500 · half to start, half on delivery

You \$1,000 after the plant pays
